'Learning Hebrew in Medieval England'

Judith Olszowy-Schlanger has a BA and MA from Paris and a doctorate from Cambridge. She is President of OCHJS, Director of the Centre for Hebrew & Jewish Studies, Faculty of Asian & Middle Eastern Studies and a Fellow, Corpus Christi College. She is also Professor of Hebrew Manuscript Studies at the École pratique des hautes études and a member of PSL Research University. Her main research interests and publications concern the study of medieval Hebrew manuscripts as cultural objects, from the point of view of their text, material features and script and the role they played in Jewish intellectual, religious and social life. She is interested in the contacts between Jews and their non-Jewish intellectual environments, especially at the level of book culture.

Abstract: Today she will present her recent book, *Learning Hebrew in Medieval England: Christian Scholars and the Longleat House Grammar* (Toronto, PIMS, 2023).
